The children have a snack (parents/guardians are invited), participate in Bible Study and have choir practice. We look forward to nurturing your children through any or all of these ministries.

Jr./Sr. High Youth—known as “Fusion”. The name for the group is based on Romans 6:5, which says, “If we have been united with Him like this in His death, we will certainly also be united with Him in His resurrection.” (NIV). Fusion means coming together or uniting. Join us on Sunday mornings and evenings and Wednesday evenings.
