The Koinonia Sunday School Class meets in Room 107 at 9:45 a.m. every Sunday under the leadership of Rev. Barry Smith. Our eight week study entitled: “**The Apostles Creed, the meaning, message and mission embodied in our affirmation of faith.**” will begin on January 20th.
