Ages 0 thru 5th grade

**Nursery**, for children up to age 3, is available during Worship, Sunday School, WFN, Bible Studies, and meetings.

**Sunday School** (from 9:45 – 10:45), for children 2 years thru 5<sup>th</sup> grade, is offered in our Education Building (across the breezeway).

**Children's Worship** is offered for children thru 5<sup>th</sup> grade. They begin in the sanctuary with their families and are dismissed after Children's Moments or the Gloria Patria. 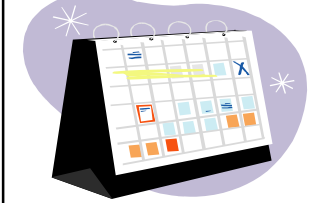
