Ages 0 thru 5th grade

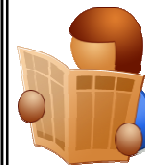

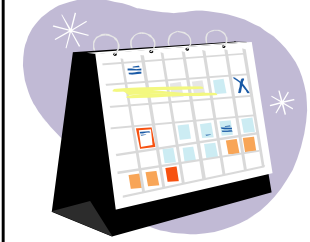
