Ed will be in Jail on October 30, Noon, at the Rockfish Grill. Make a donation to bail him out of jail.

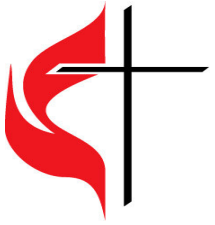

OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDY



The **Koinonia Sunday School Class** meets in Room 107 at 9:45 a.m. every Sunday under the leadership of Rev. Barry Smith. Soon we will be looking back on General Conference 2008 and we should be assessing the state and direction of our denomination as determined by policies formulated and confirmed and by resolutions considered and adopted or lost. Over the next eight weeks we will be studying the words of our Lord to the SEVEN CHURCHES in The Revelation of John Chapters 2 and 3 and what He is saying to the Church today. Everyone is welcome.

The **Oasis Class** meets on Sunday morning in Room 106A, expressing their love for Christ and Christian care and concern for others through acts of kindness, giving, and lively round table discussion facilitated by various class members. The **Quest Sunday School Class** meets in Room 106 in the Education Annex. Quest is currently studying the book of James

The **Fellowship Sunday School Class** meets at 9:45 in Room 104 A. The lessons for the fall quarter will look at the New Testament through the eyes of the community. We discuss the core values and teachings of this new community and conclude with a focus on a community of servants. This study explores how the community members were equipped for ministry, how they handled conflict, their witness in the world and the persecution they faced because of their witness.

For Children, ages 0 thru 5th grade: Nursery is available for children up to age 3. We have **Sunday School** for children ages 2 years thru 5th grade in our Education Building across the breezeway. **Children's Worship** is for children 3 years thru 3rd grade. They begin in the sanctuary with their families and are dismissed after Children's Moments or the Gloria Patri. (Note: Children's Church does not meet on Communion Sundays.) The children are divided into two groups: **Promise Kids**, for children ages 3 thru 5 years, meets in the Nursery. **Children's Church**, for children in grades K thru 3rd grade, meets in Room 108A; straight down the hall, the last room on the right. **WFN**—Wesley Fellowship Night is on Wednesday evenings from 5:15—7:30 for children ages 4 years thru 5th grade. The children have Bible Study time, eat dinner (parents/guardians are invited) and have choir practice. We look forward to nurturing your children through any or all of these ministries.

Jr./Sr. High Youth—known as “Fusion”. The name for the group is based on Romans 6:5, which says, “If we have been united with Him like this in His death, we will certainly also be united with Him in His resurrection.” (NIV). Fusion means coming together or uniting. Join us on Sunday mornings and evenings and Wednesday evenings.

Women's Bible Study meets Tuesday nights at 7 p.m. in the Oasis SS Classroom. Our new topic is **John 3:16** Led by Shirley Clark.
